



Bartending Agreement

The Bartender/Bartending Service must have a TABC Liquor License as well as Liquor Liability insurance; and a copy of each must be on file with The Venue 30 days prior to Client's Event.

Liquor may be served on the premises, consistent with the laws, rules and regulations of the State of Texas and other regulator authorities.

All servers of alcohol must be certified by TABC and their proof of certification must also be on file with The Venue.

Everyone under the age of 35 must be carded. The Bartender is responsible to ensure that minors are not served, guests do not become inebriated and that any other effects of excessive alcohol consumption do not occur.

It is the Bartender's sole obligation to ensure compliance with TABC Laws, rules and regulations.

1. Bartending Service ("Bartender") agrees to follow bar service rules:
 - a. Bartender can use the service doors for loading and unloading supplies, etc.
 - b. After unloading, all bartending personnel must park in the parking lot behind Los Fontanas.
 - c. All kegs and ice chests must be on a mat.
 - d. All leftover alcohol must be stacked neatly and placed on a table in the service kitchen.
 - e. Remove all bar trash to onsite dumpster. Venue will provide trash cans and trash bags.
 - f. Place bar trashcan(s) in caterer's kitchen. (You do not need to replace trash bags at the end of the night)
 - g. Do a final walk-through **with a Venue Staff Member** to ensure that the bar area is restored to the condition it was in prior to the event and all debris has been removed.
2. Failure to adhere to all the rules and regulations of this Agreement may result in the termination of Bartender's use of The Venue.
